

A Visit to Igloo Dairy



At ISMS we conduct Industry visits in and out of Pune. Industry visits make students aware of the practical challenges facing companies in the world of business. Industrial visits also clarify different management concepts for students as they can see how these concepts are implemented.

International School of Management Studies, Pune under the guidance of Prof. Rashmi Nair, Administrative Coordinator organized an Industrial Visit Igloo Dairy, Goa in February 2020. The industrial visit aimed to acquaint the students with the process of the Dairy Industry.

Igloo Dairy Services Pvt. Ltd. was established in 1973 and provides comprehensive dairy services for its clients' brands (which include Amul, KMF, Gowardhan and Gokul amongst others). Since the early 1990s, Igloo has been providing comprehensive dairy services to milk marketing companies for processing (chilling, cream separation, standardisation, homogenising, clarification, pasteurising) and pouch packing their liquid milk under their brands. Igloo's dairies are located at consuming centres. Liquid milk is received at the dairies in road tankers. Crated milk is handed over to the clients' distributors at our cold stores' delivery docks. In 2013 Igloo started to handle fermented milk products (dahi, yoghurt, curd, buttermilk, chaas, lassi).

The Visit began at 12 p.m. with a video about Igloo Dairy. The video included an introduction of Igloo Dairy, procurement of milk, transportation of milk, testing of milk, processing and pasteurization of milk and other dairy products etc. They showed the students how the milk processing machines like boilers, chillers etc work. He also showed the students all the production departments like Flavoured Milk, Ghee processing, etc.

The visit concluded at 2 p.m. with a treat of fresh milk and a refreshing glass of chass. The visit was organized by Prof. Rashmi Nair along with Prof. Dingre.
